


# 伊豆の国市 歴史と文化のまちで地球を感じる


**城山 Mt. Joyama**  
狩野川のほとりにそびえる城山は、かつて海底火山の地下にあった「火山の根」。伊豆と本州の衝突に伴う隆起とその後の浸食で姿を現しました。Mt. Joyama is "volcanic neck" that is a rocky hill created magma solidifying along the vent of a submarine volcano. The brittle outer layers of the volcano was eroded and only a volcanic neck remains.



**葛城山 Mt. Katsuragiya**  
豆のなりたちを物語るさまざまな景観や富士山、狩野川の流れを一望できます。Mt. Katsuragiya is also one of the "volcanic necks." From the mountain top that can be reached by aerial ropeway, you can get a view of various landscapes, Mt. Fuji and the Kanogawa River.



**地震動の擦痕 Stria of Earthquake**  
丹那断層の活動で生じた北伊豆地震(1930年)による揺れが、戦没者慰霊碑に展示されていた雷雷側面にひっかかり傷として記録されました。The shock of the Kitaizu Earthquake occurred in 1930 as a result of activities made by the Tanna Fault was recorded as a scratch on the torpedo put on display on the war memorial.



**北江間横穴群 Kitaema Ancient Graves**  
海底火山の噴火で降りつもった火山灰や軽石の地層に作られた横穴式の古墳は古くから狩野川流域に暮らしてきた人々の暮らしを今に伝えます。Tunnel tombs in the strata of volcanic ash and pumice due to eruption of submarine volcanoes show ways of living done by people who settled down along the river in the distant past.
