













いずはんとう 伊豆半島には、山が海まで迫り、けわしい崖が続く海岸が多く The Izu Peninsula has many coasts with steep cliffs. Fu-あります。舟山の集落はこうした海岸線の中の緩やかな傾斜地に あります。集落内の家の敷地や畑は傾斜地を階段状に造成して作 られているため、立派なイシバ(石垣)があちこちで見られます。

舟山のまわりの大地は約50万年前まで噴火を繰り返していた 達磨火山が作りました。噴火を終えた達磨火山は長年の浸食によ って削られてきました。こうして削られ川を流れ下った土砂が厚く たまり、舟山の緩斜面ができました。そのため、集落内を流れる3 本の川や海岸の崖ではたくさんの大きな岩が見つかります。

nayama village is located on a gentle slope in such coast. The house grounds and cultivated lands in the village are developed by leveling the sloped land, so you can see many stone walls which develop the flat lands in the village.

The land around Funayama was formed by Darumayama Volcano, which had been erupting until about 500,000 years ago. This volcano has been eroded for a long time after the eruption. And the sediments that flowed down the rivers due to erosion accumulated thickly, and the gentle slope of Funayama was formed. Therefore, many large rocks can be found in the three rivers flowing through the village and on coastal cliffs.
